## ACTIVITIES

### Snorkeling

The yacht is equipped with snorkeling to cater for 6 guests.

### Game Fishing

Is provided while under way from one point to another by trolling lures. Standard Rods, reels and lures are provided. You are welcome to take your own game or light tackle fishing equipment.

### Tender Boats

Skipped by a staff member, the 3.8 m semi rigid inflatable is available to take guests to the Islands to explore or to go snorkeling or diving at the skipper's discretion.

**NB:** Although alternative activities are provided the majority of the group determines the direction of the flow and those not in the majority need to understand that a yacht is not a resort with endless staff to see to a variety of activities all at the same time. This package is sold as a fishing trip. However if a single group is chartering the yacht the group together with the skipper & host can discuss the groups needs and formulate a plan that ensures that all preferences in the group are met based on conditions and the skippers discretion.

## GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS

- Combination packages are available in which you have a choice to spend a portion of your stay on land in beach side hotels as well as on the yacht.
- Please bear in mind that Mozambique is a third world country and while every effort is made to compensate for this fact, a wide variety of supplies, spares etc are not always readily available.
